


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PRECAUTIONS

Before attempting to hook up and operate, please read this manual.


- 1. To reduce the risk of electronic shock, do not remove cover or back. No user serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.
- 2. Never point the camera toward the sun. It should not expose the lens directly to sun or strong light as this may damage the pick-up device.
- 3. Handle this camera with care. Avoid severe shock or impact to the camera as it contains sensitive parts which can be damaged by improper handling.
- 4. The allowance temperature range for operation of this camera is between -20 to 65° (-4 to 146°F) and the allowable humidity is 85% maximum. If the camera is to be placed in an extremely dusty location, a special housing may be necessary to protect the camera and lens.



HOW TO CONNECT THE CABLE

Follow the instructions below when connecting the cable and camera.


STEP 1:

Line up the position marks on the male connector and female connector as shown in image below.



STEP 2:

Rotate the ring on the male connector by hand as shown in image below.



STEP 3:

Then screw in securely to the threads on the female connector.



INSTALLATION

When mounting the camera, proceed as follows:


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Hold the camera on the chosen location and mark at least two different points for the drill holes.



STEP 2:

When fastening with self-tapping screws, drill 0 5.5 mm holes at the points you have just marked.



STEP 3:

Screw the camera bracket on with the 6 x 20 mm self-tapping screws.

STEP 4:

When attaching with threaded screws, drill 6.5 mm holes at the points you have just marked.



INSTALLATION

When mounting the camera, proceed as follows:


STEP 5:	
Screw the camera bracket on with the M6 x 20 mm threaded screws.	
STEP 6:	11
Creating a through-hole for the camera connection cable, drill a hole of 16mm near the camera.	
STEP 7:	
Mount the camera by pushing the camera into the camera bracket.	
STEP 8:	
Attach the camera loosely with the 4 screws M3 x 10 mm in the slots.	

INSTALLATION

When mounting the camera, proceed as follows:


STEP 9:


Tighten the 4 screws in the slots of the camera bracket.



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3RD EYE WARRANTY

3RD EYE PRODUCTS LIMITED WARRANTY

3rd Eye warrants that the 3rd Eye Hardware and Software, as delivered by 3rd Eye to Client, will be free from defects in materials and workmanship in accordance to the terms and conditions specified herein. This warranty is a "parts replacement only" policy, and does not cover labor. Other limitations apply as provided below.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 "Hardware" means cameras, monitors, Gateway and related peripheral hardware.
- 1.2 "Software" shall mean the Application or Embedded Software.
- 1.3 "Self-Service Client" shall mean any client that maintains their own equipment and is not under Service Agreement with 3rd Eye.

WARRANTY PERIOD

- 2.1 Unless a separate written Agreement with 3rd Eye is provided, a 1 Year warranty from the original date of hardware installation or the original date of purchase, whichever occurs first shall apply. Troubleshooting, labor, travel time, freight and miscellaneous costs are not covered.
- 2.2 New replacement hardware covered under warranty shall be covered under warranty for the remaining period of the initial warranty term.
- 2.4 Refurbished hardware and hardware installed by the customer shall carry a 90-day replacement warranty from the original date of hardware installation or the original date of purchase, whichever occurs first shall apply.
- 2.5 Labor and workmanship provided by a certified 3rd Eye technician shall carry a 90-day replacement warranty from the original date of service.

WARRANTY REIMBURSEMENT

- 3.1 To submit for warranty reimbursement, Client must notify 3rd Eye in writing by obtaining a 3rd Eye Return Material Authorization (RMA) number within the relevant Warranty Period. The authorized RMA the Client receives must be marked on the outside of the package returning the failed component and sent prepaid and packaged appropriately for safe shipment. The RMA number will serve as the warranty claim reference number. 3rd Eye will either repair or replace the defective component at its discretion. - 3.2 If the failure analysis of the returned hardware determines the cause of failure was other than material or workmanship covered under the terms of this limited warranty, the CUSTOMER agrees to pay 3rd Eye Cam for the replacement hardware, labor and expenses.

WARRANTY DISCLAIMER

- 4.1 This warranty shall become null, void, and not apply if Client fails to notify 3rd Eye in writing of such defects prior to the expiration of the Warranty Period, if the defect is not reproducible, or if the defect is caused by (a) customer damage, negligence, misuse, tampering, accident, fire, variation or interruption of electricity; (b) failure by Client to properly install, maintain, or use the 3rd Eye Hardware or the Third Party Hardware; (c) alterations made by anyone other than 3rd Eye to the 3rd Eye Hardware or the hardware and/or software that interfaces with the 3rd Eye Hardware after installation; (d) any attempt to service the 3rd Eye Hardware other than by 3rd Eye's service technicians or (e) any hardware, software or part not approved by or not supplied by 3rd Eye. 3rd Eye shall not be responsible for the safeguarding or retention of Client's or any third-party software, firmware, information or memory data contained in, stored on, or integrated with any 3rd Eye Hardware that is returned to 3rd Eye pursuant to any warranty provided under this Agreement.
