INTRODUCTION

3rd Eye cameras are designed to improve safety during driving by providing high quality images of surrounding areas and obstacles in the vicinity of the vehicle.

They will also improve vehicle maneuvering capability by displaying blind spots not normally visible to the driver.

Please ensure you read and understand all aspects of this manual before fitting or using your 3rd Eye Camera. Choose a suitable mounting place dependent on the application. Ensure that there are no wiring harnesses or hoses/pipes located behind this panel before drilling.


The camera is designed for small car rear view system. It is easy to mount on your car with the bracket being hidden by your license plate.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Remove the rear license plate.

STEP 2


Place the bracket behind the license plate and line up the holes. Fasten the camera mounting bracket and the license plate to the vehicle using the anti-theft screws provided. Determine the mounting location that best suits your needs. Be sure to verify that your installation plan complies with local laws and regulations.

STEP 3

Install the camera and adjust to the correct angle.

STEP 4


Seal with supplied silicon tape to ensure waterproof. Run extension cable inside the vehicle.

CHECKING AND SETTINGS

- 1. Check the function of the camera after you have connected it to a monitor.
- 2. Align the camera using the image on the monitor to help you:
 - a. The monitor image should show the rear or the bumper of the vehicle at the bottom edge of the screen.
 - b. The middle of the bumper should be in the middle of the screen.
- 3. Tighten the fastening screws of the camera bracket.
- 4. Settings for contrast and brightness can be made on the monitor.

CLEANING AND CARING

Clean the camera with a soft, damp cloth from time to time.

Do not use sharp or hard objects to clean the device as these may damage the device.

3RD EYE WARRANTY

3RD EYE PRODUCTS LIMITED WARRANTY

3rd Eye warrants that the 3rd Eye Hardware and Software, as delivered by 3rd Eye to Client, will be free from defects in materials and workmanship in accordance to the terms and conditions specified herein. This warranty is a "parts replacement only" policy, and does not cover labor. Other limitations apply as provided below.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 "Hardware" means cameras, monitors, Gateway and related peripheral hardware.
- 1.2 "Software" shall mean the Application or Embedded Software.
- 1.3 "Self-Service Client" shall mean any client that maintains their own equipment and is not under Service Agreement with 3rd Eye.

WARRANTY PERIOD

- 2.1 Unless a separate written Agreement with 3rd Eye is provided, a 1 Year warranty from the original date of hardware installation or the original date of purchase, whichever occurs first shall apply. Troubleshooting, labor, travel time, freight and miscellaneous costs are not covered.
- 2.2 New replacement hardware covered under warranty shall be covered under warranty for the remaining period of the initial warranty term.
- 2.4 Refurbished hardware and hardware installed by the customer shall carry a 90-day replacement warranty from the original date of hardware installation or the original date of purchase, whichever occurs first shall apply.
- 2.5 Labor and workmanship provided by a certified 3rd Eye technician shall carry a 90-day replacement warranty from the original date of service.

WARRANTY REIMBURSEMENT

- 3.1 To submit for warranty reimbursement, Client must notify 3rd Eye in writing by obtaining a 3rd Eye Return Material Authorization (RMA) number within the relevant Warranty Period. The authorized RMA the Client receives must be marked on the outside of the package returning the failed component and sent prepaid and packaged appropriately for safe shipment. The RMA number will serve as the warranty claim reference number. 3rd Eye will either repair or replace the defective component at its discretion. - 3.2 If the failure analysis of the returned hardware determines the cause of failure was other than material or workmanship covered under the terms of this limited warranty, the CUSTOMER agrees to pay 3rd Eye Cam for the replacement hardware, labor and expenses.

WARRANTY DISCLAIMER

- 4.1 This warranty shall become null, void, and not apply if Client fails to notify 3rd Eye in writing of such defects prior to the expiration of the Warranty Period, if the defect is not reproducible, or if the defect is caused by (a) customer damage, negligence, misuse, tampering, accident, fire, variation or interruption of electricity; (b) failure by Client to properly install, maintain, or use the 3rd Eye Hardware or the Third Party Hardware; (c) alterations made by anyone other than 3rd Eye to the 3rd Eye Hardware or the hardware and/or software that interfaces with the 3rd Eye Hardware after installation; (d) any attempt to service the 3rd Eye Hardware other than by 3rd Eye's service technicians or (e) any hardware, software or part not approved by or not supplied by 3rd Eye. 3rd Eye shall not be responsible for the safeguarding or retention of Client's or any third-party software, firmware, information or memory data contained in, stored on, or integrated with any 3rd Eye Hardware that is returned to 3rd Eye pursuant to any warranty provided under this Agreement.
